

Town of Whitefield
Select Board Meeting Minutes
June 13, 2017, 6 PM

Present: Bill McKeen, Lester Sheaffer, Charlene Donahue, Frank Ober. Absent: Tony Marple and Aaron Miller, Administrative Assistant.

1. Meeting was called to order by Vice Chair, Frank Ober.
2. A motion was made and seconded to accept the June 6 minutes. Motion carried.
3. Andy Goode of Atlantic Salmon Federation reported to the board about the preparation of plans for submission to the town for formal approval to remove the Coopers Mills Dam. He also spoke about preparing a development application to the town. Fire hydrants will be operational soon.
4. Paving bids were opened from 10 companies. The bids will be reviewed by Frank Ober and Dennis Merrill so that the bids can be awarded at the next select board meeting.
5. A crack sealing bid was opened from Pro Seal. It was moved and seconded to award the contract to Pro Seal. Motion carried.
6. A brush cutting bid was opened from Spicer Tree Specialists. A motion was made and seconded to award the brush cutting contract to Spicer. Motion carried.
8. Accounts payable and payroll warrants were signed by the select board.
9. Auto recyclers and graveyards in Whitefield will be contacted by letter to fill out license applications. A date for a public hearing will be set after applications are filed.
10. The select board has had complaints about several junkyards and Codes Enforcement Officer Arthur Strout will notify owners of those junkyards to either apply for a junkyard permit or clean up the properties after 60 days.
11. Frank Ober and Bill McKeen reported to the select board results of a meeting with the Lemieux's regarding the future of the Whitefield Food Bank.
12. Tony Marple will contact the town auditor regarding town office bookkeeping.
13. The select board will contact the planning board for an update on Mark Fenderson's development application.
