

Town of Whitefield  
Select Board Meeting Minutes  
September 5, 2017, 6 PM

Present: Tony Marple, Bill McKeen, Lester Sheaffer, Frank Ober and Aaron Miller, Administrative Assistant. Charlene Donahue was absent.

1. Meeting was called to order by Chair, Tony Marple.
2. A motion was made and seconded to accept the August 29th minutes as revised. Motion carried.
3. A motion was made and seconded to adopt the General Assistance Appendices.
4. A report was made by Erik Ekholm of the road committee about the purchase of traffic signs and posts from the Maine Department of Transportation at a 25% discount. A motion was made and seconded to purchase the signs and posts listed by Erik and add to it a list signs and posts recorded by Aaron Miller. Motion carried.
5. Erik suggested that snow blocks on the fire station roof and gutters above the entrance doors along with proper shoveling of snow be tried for next winter before building roof structures above the doors as had been planned.
6. Accounts payable and payroll warrants were signed by the select board.
7. A 2017 Quarter Review of Assessments was provided to the select board by Everett "Zeke" Pike, CMA. The net gain in valuation was reported to be \$141,000. The board will ask the assessors if our 10 year tree growth plans are being verified.
8. Bill McKeen reported that more revisions will be made to the junkyard policy before it can be adopted by the board.
9. An RFP has been sent out for the tree removal on Hollywood Boulevard. Bid opening will be September 19th.
10. Driveway aprons will be paved on Townhouse Road by B & B Paving after removing the temporary gravel. Dave West of B & B Paving will be asked to attend the next select board meeting.
11. A motion was made and seconded to proclaim the week of September 17 - 23 as Constitution Week at the request of the Daughters of the American Revolution. Motion carried.
12. Aaron reported that the Maine Department of Transportation will remove and old culvert and replace with a new culvert on Route 194 in 2020.
