Coopers Mills - Alternate Plan B Legend

- Parking area: 5 head-in parking spaces, graded to property line with low retaining wall.
- **2. Dam site entry:** Create an even sloped surface to abutment overlook. Locate site orientation information here.
- Abutment overlook: Stabilize existing concrete abutment or reconstruct with reclaimed stone masonry construction. Add railing and safe access from entry.
- 4. Fish ladder: Convert upper portion of the fish ladder into a concrete staircase to the Lower Mill Garden Terrace.

 Maintain lower portion of fishway baffles for interpretive and educational purposes.
- **5.** Lower mill garden terrace: Remove weeds, debris, trash and graffiti. Clear a pathway through the mill ruin rubble for visitor access.
- 6. Foundation ruin viewing platform:
 Dismantle the tall, unstable, upper
 portion of the wall; reuse materials to
 reconstruct wall at a lower elevation
 with tall steps for access to the top
 viewing platform. Install handrail at
 waters edge.
- Potential alternate access trail: Access to Upper Terrace Overlook to be determined.
- Mill ruin retaining wall: Remove woody plants and preserve/restore the historic dry-stacked stone foundation retaining wall.
- 9. Upper terrace overlook: Remove invasive species and midstory growth blocking views; limb branches as necessary to open views. Regrade and grass overlook area and provide bench(es).

- **10. Picnic overlook:** Construct low retaining wall to create turfed overlook area for picnicking area.
- 11. Fish ladder lower terrace: Remove weeds, debris, trash, and graffiti.

 Maintain rubble area with limited
- **12. Fish ladder sunken passage:** No improvements
- **13. Abutment rock garden:** Stabilize area behind abutment after abutment reconstruction. Fill with repurposed stone material from spillway demolition.
- **14. Interpretive site elements and signage:** Provide discovery and
 learning opportunities by dispersing
 subtle interpretive elements
 throughout the site. (as budget allows)
- 15. Terrace edge seatwall: (Alt A only)
- **16. Historic site commemoration:**Bronze plaque in bedrock foundation of the old mill foundation retaining wall. (optional)
- **17. Stone steppers:** Provide stone stepper angling access to river near bridge.
- **18. Trash receptacle:** Locate a trash receptable at site entry.
- **19. Entry kiosk:** Construct a small kiosk at existing concrete wall.
- **20. Interpretive signage:** Interpretive signage panels orient visitors to the site and provide history and watershed context.
