Article 2: To elect by secret ballot municipal officers namely, one (1) Select Board Member/ Assessor/ Overseer of the Poor for a three-year term; two (2) RSU 12 School Board Members, one for a two-year term and one for a three-year term; three openings on the Planning Board, one for a one-year term and two three-year terms.
