

## Minutes Town Meeting General Referendum Election 11.8.22 Town of Whitefield

Yolanda Violette, Town Clerk, opened the Town Meeting General Referendum Election at 8:00 am.

GREETINGS,

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the residents of the Town of Whitefield, Maine in Lincoln County, qualified to vote on Town affairs, to assemble at the Whitefield Central Fire Station located at 24 Townhouse Road in said Town of Whitefield on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 at 8:00 AM, then and there to act on Article 1 and by secret ballot on Article 2 as set out below, the polling hours therefor to be from 8:00 AM until 8:00 PM, said articles being the following:

<u>Article 1:</u> To elect a Moderator by written ballot to preside at said meeting.

Nominations were opened for Moderator, a motion for Cynthia St. Peter with no other nominations.

Cynthia St. Peter was nominated to serve as Moderator, it was moved and seconded,

With No discussion,

Then went to vote by paper ballot. Yolanda Violette collected ballots, 4-0 for Cynthia St. Peter

## \*ARTICLE 1: The Town voted to elect Cynthia St. Peter as Moderator to preside at said meeting.

The town clerk administered the Oath of office to Mrs. Cynthia St. Peter

Tina Laskey was elected Deputy Moderator at 4:30 till close of Polls and sworn in.
