



Town of Whitefield Proof of Residency Policy

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to have in writing the acceptable forms for Proof of Residency for conducting business, i.e., vehicle registrations, Inland Fisheries & Wildlife transactions, etc., in the Town of Whitefield.

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

Both the State of Maine Bureau of Motor Vehicles as well as State of Maine Inland Fisheries & Wildlife require that before conducting business with anyone at our counter, that we ask them to prove their residency in our town. Per both agencies, acceptable forms of proof of residency are:

- Valid State of Maine motor vehicle operator license, with a valid Whitefield Street address
- Valid State of Maine motor vehicle registration, issued by the Town of Whitefield
- Valid State of Maine fishing or hunting license, issued by the Town of Whitefield
- Current invoice from a utility company in the name of the person, listing the physical address
- Rental Agreement, listing the physical address
- Mortgage Agreement, listing the physical address
- Current Voter Registration in the Town of Whitefield
- A written and notarized statement from whomever they may be residing with, we will then verify that person's residency.
